Chinatown BID Interim Board Nomination

Selection Criteria

- 1. Individuals must be in support of the mission of the Chinatown Business Improvement District (BID).
- 2. Individuals must be ready, willing and able to make contribution to achieve the BID's mission and its effective governance.
- 3. Individuals must be ready, willing and able to actively serve on the Board and its committees and attend its official functions.
- 4. Individuals have demonstrated leadership abilities and communication skills.

Interim Board Nomination Process

- 1. A Nomination Committee of 7 volunteers was approved by the BID Steering Committee.
- 2. a) Nomination Committee welcomes qualified and interested parties to apply.
 - b) In addition to City Council's invitation, the Nomination Committee posts notice and application on websites to solicit individual applicants for consideration to be nominated to the Interim Board.
 - c) Nomination Committee also asks Steering Committee members to provide additional individual recommendations.
- 3. Nomination Committee evaluates applicants based on the above 4 criteria, and recommends a slate of Interim Board of Directors.
- 4. Nomination Committee presents slate to Steering Committee for approval.
